1 PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

- 1. New Covid Health Check APP District is moving to a daily checklist that consists of 2 Tiers of symptoms. Tier 1 symptoms require a COVID test; Tier 2 symptoms don't necessarily require a COVID test, but will require your child to stay home. Watch for info re: this new app to be sent to you shortly. The info from the app does not get sent to the school, but lets parents know next steps.
- 2. FSA Foundation Skills Assessment is done with all Grade 4 and 7 students. It assesses how students are doing in a variety of areas. GME uses the info to identify areas that the student may need a little extra support.
- 3. MDI Middle Years Development Instrument. Self-report questionnaire that asks Grade 5 students to think and feel about their experiences in and out of school, including physical health and well-being, connectedness, social and emotional development, school experiences, use of after school time. This questionnaire is confidential, so neither the school nor the parent knows who gave what answers, unless the child answers at the end of the questionnaire that they'd like to speak to someone about it.
- 4. Big Brothers and Big Sisters Has a variety of mentoring programs, currently being held online, for kids. Watch for information coming soon.
- 5. Cross Walk Safety There may be a possibility of having parent volunteers or supervisors who can act as crossing guards in the morning and afternoon to ensure safety of kids getting to school.
